PRINCIPALS REPORT

ATTENDANCE AND SICK DAYS

You have a **legal responsibility** to send your children to school every school day, however sometimes your child may become sick at school or may be too sick to attend.

WHAT TO DO IF YOUR CHILD IS TOO UNWELL

If your child misses school due to illness, religious reasons or family circumstances, talk to your child's teacher and remember to send a signed note explaining the reason for their absence.

If your child arrives at school late or needs to leave early, you will need to go to the office to sign your child in or out.

If you're having difficulty getting your child to school every day and on time, talk to the teacher or principal.

IF YOUR CHILD IS SICK AT SCHOOL

If your child gets sick or injured at school, the school will contact you. If your child is ill, they will go to an area where they can lie down and be monitored. You will be called to come and collect your child if they are too sick to go back to the classroom. It is important to keep your contact details up to date with the school, including an alternative contact - such as a relative or neighbour - so the school can call should you be unavailable.

IF YOUR CHILD IS SICK AT HOME

From time to time your child may get sick and display symptoms that mean it's best to keep them away from school and see your doctor.

Some of these symptoms include:

- a fever of 38C or above
- vomiting or diarrhoea
- cold or flu symptoms

rashes of an unknown origin.

YOUR ROLE IN SUPPORTING ATTENDANCE

Everyone has a role supporting positive school attendance.

Regular attendance helps students to:

- develop a sense of belonging
- develop and maintain friendships
- be more engaged at school
- progress with their learning

be more aware of career and life options.

Every day counts. Missing just one day a fortnight can amount to four weeks of lost learning over a year. Over their school life, this can equal one year of missed learning.

When your child attends school every day, learning becomes easier and your child will build and maintain friendships with other children.

Parents and carers can help foster positive attendance habits by:

- helping their child learn the importance of punctuality and routine
- ensuring their child arrives on time from the start of the school day, ready to participate in learning
- reducing disruption to learning where possible, by planning any necessary appointments outside of school time
- promptly communicating any absence to the school (within 7 days of the first day of any absence)

working with the school to encourage and support regular attendance.

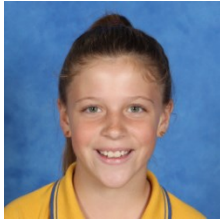


FAR NORTH COAST COMPETITIONS
